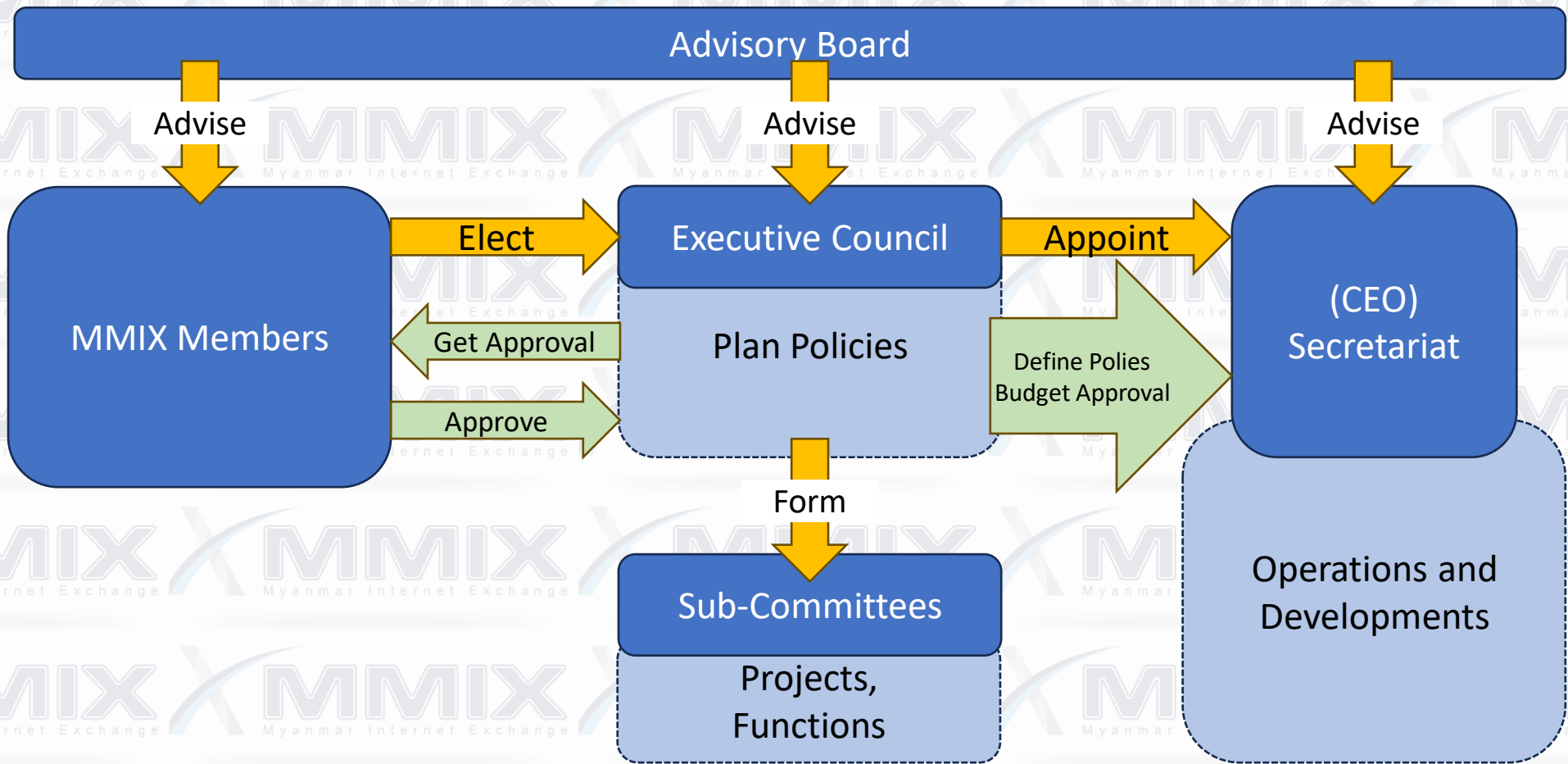

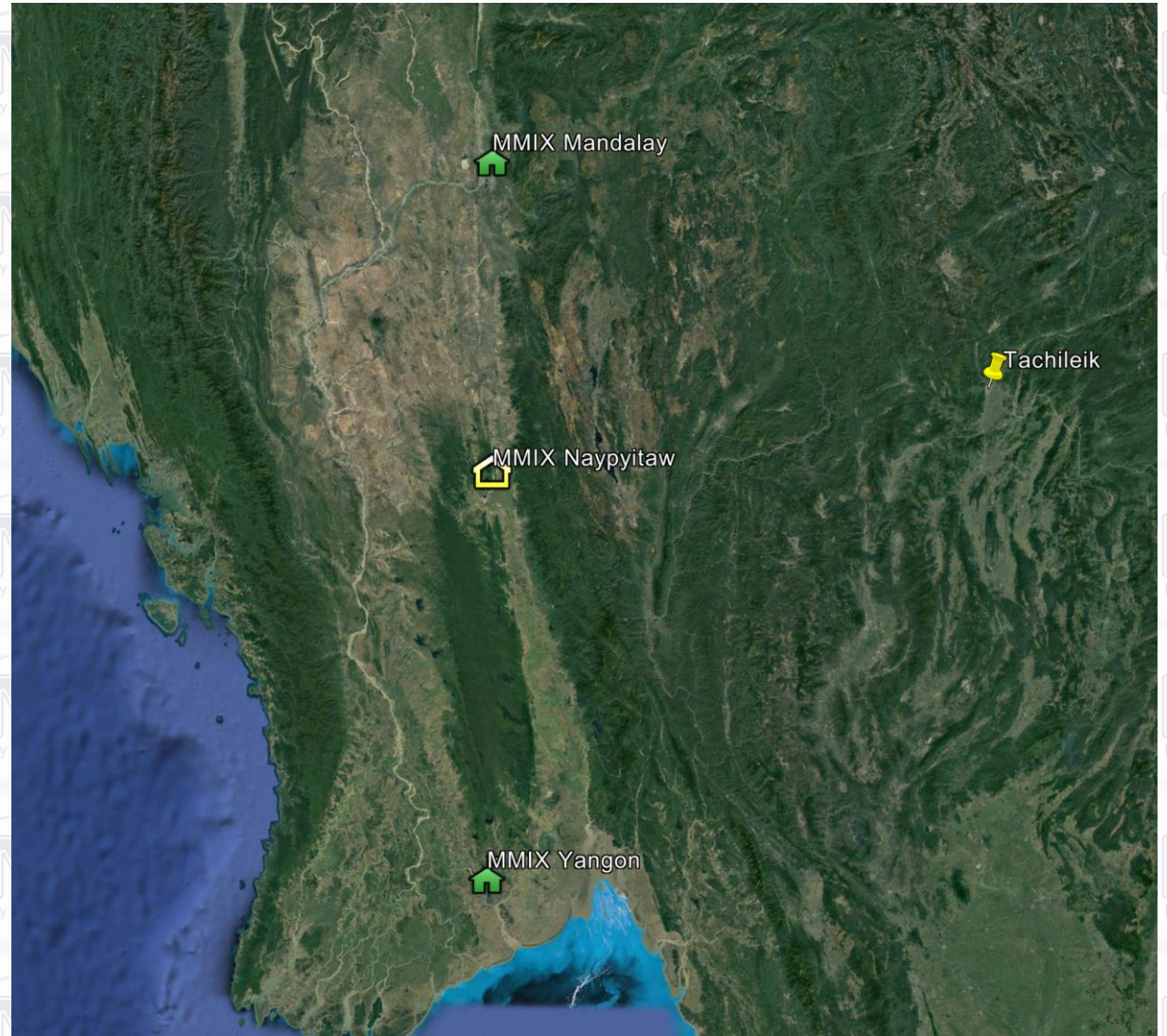

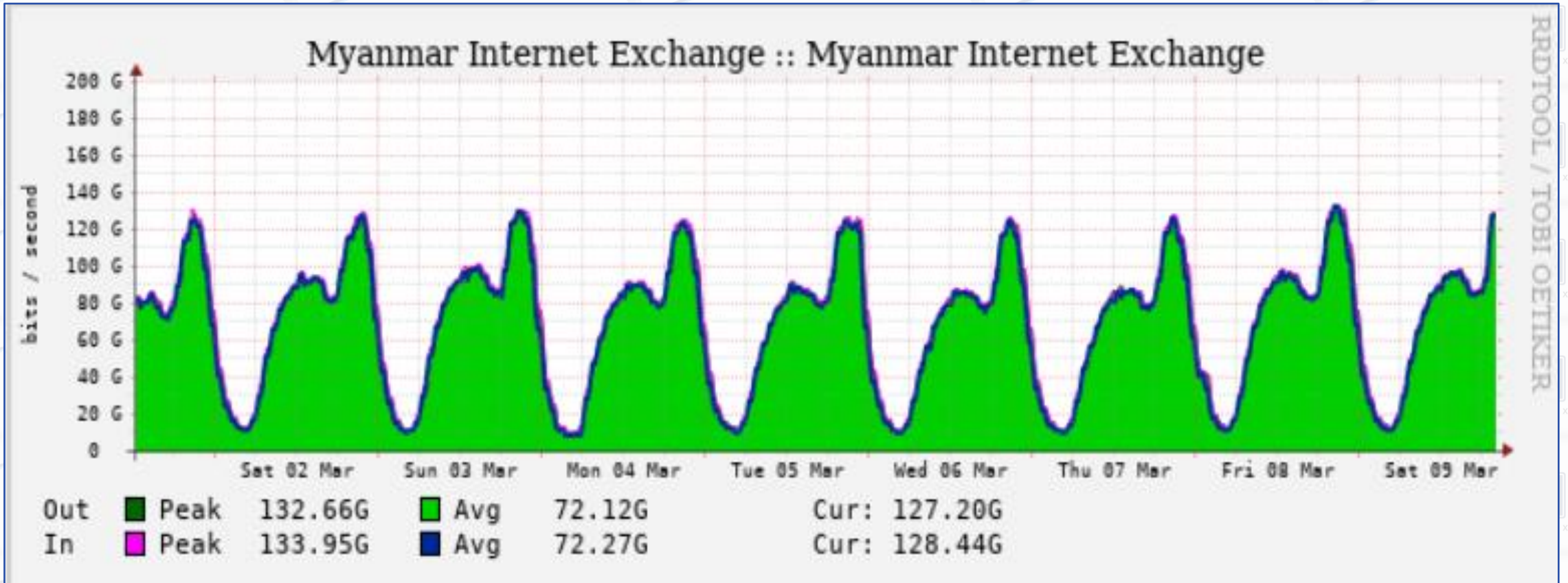

Current Traffic – Updated on 9 March 2024

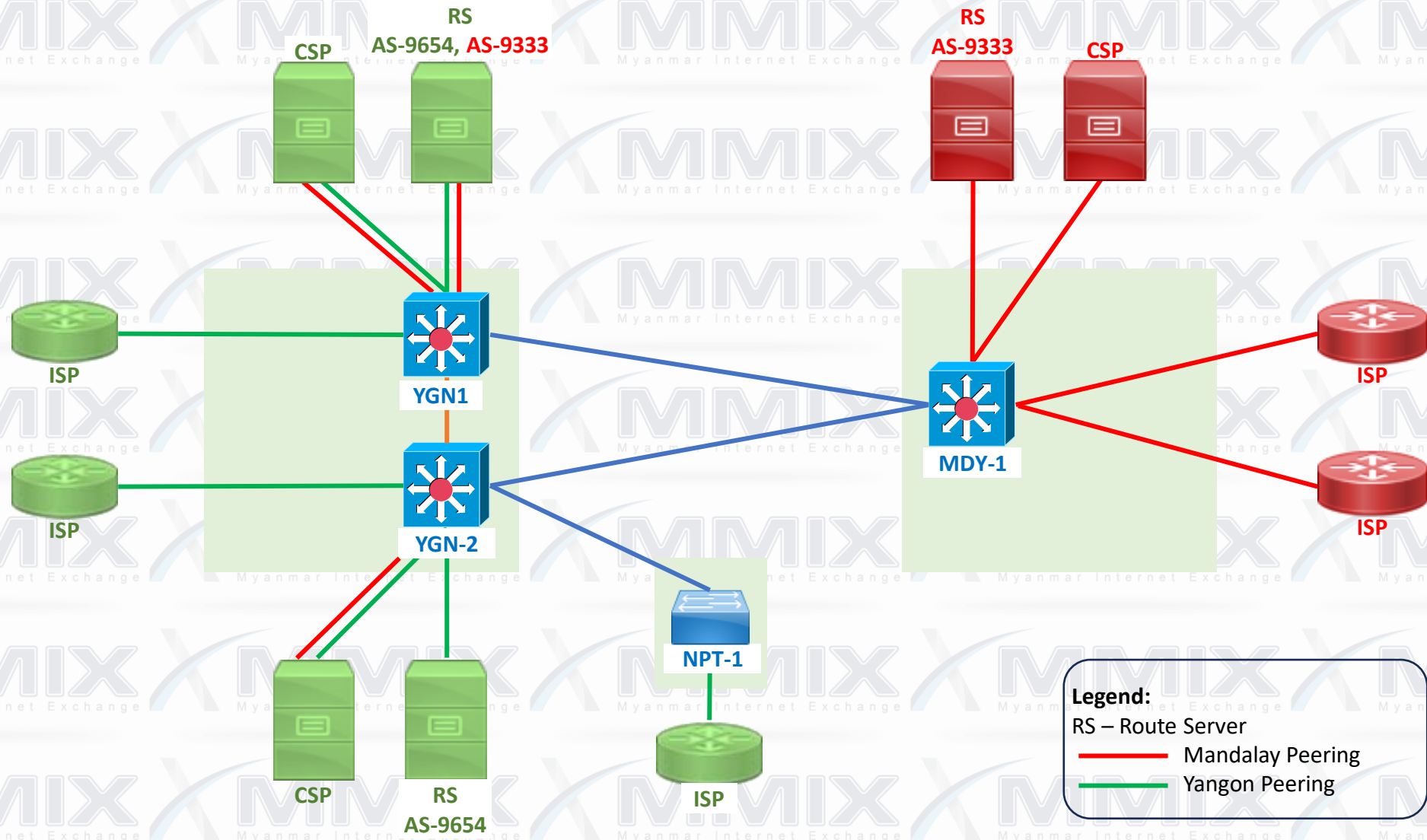

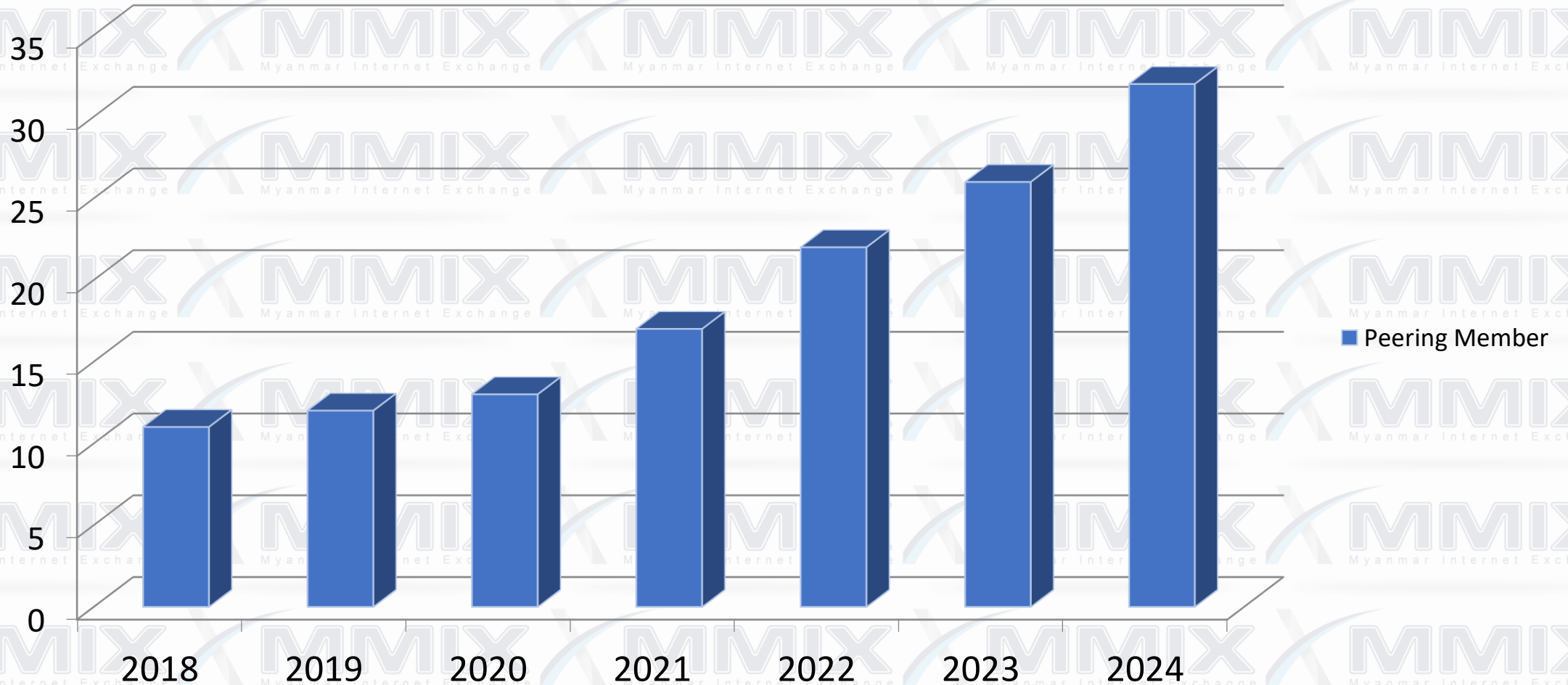

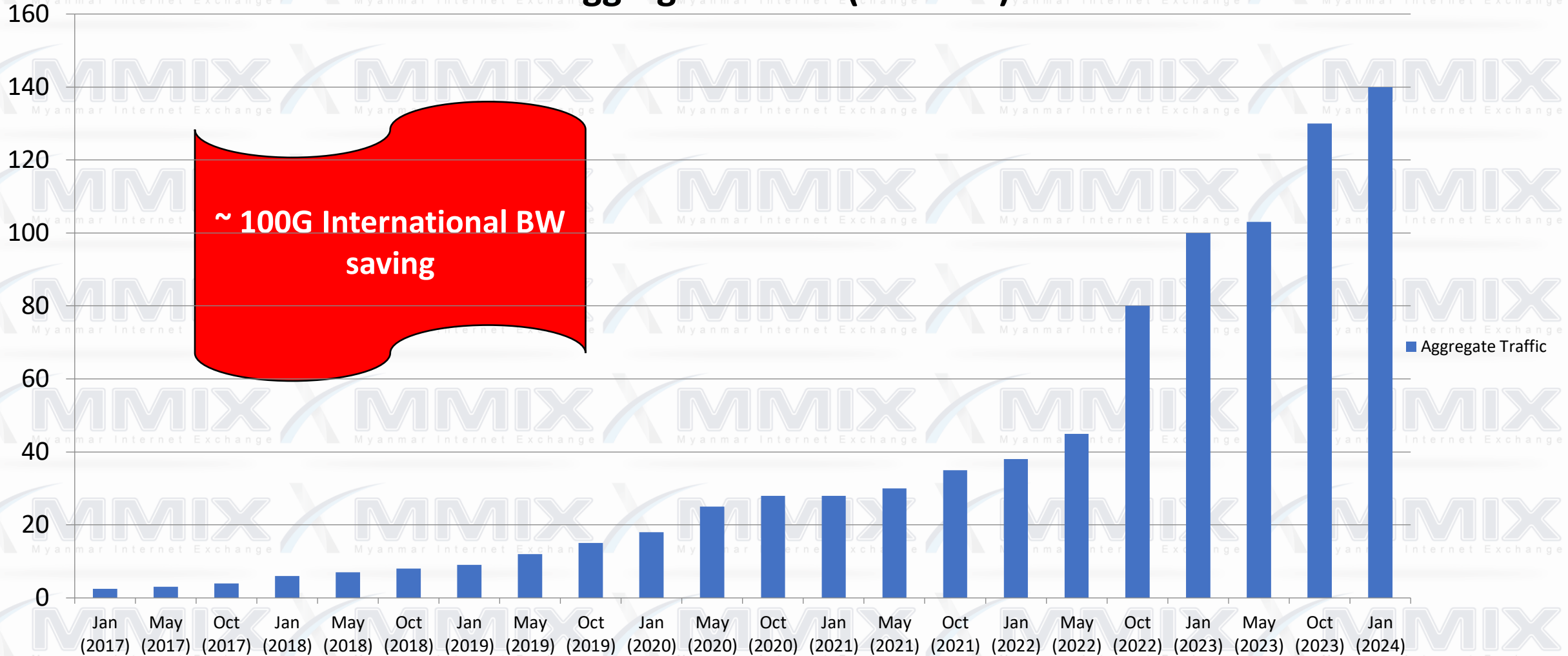
MMIX's Members Growth

MMIX's Traffic Improvement

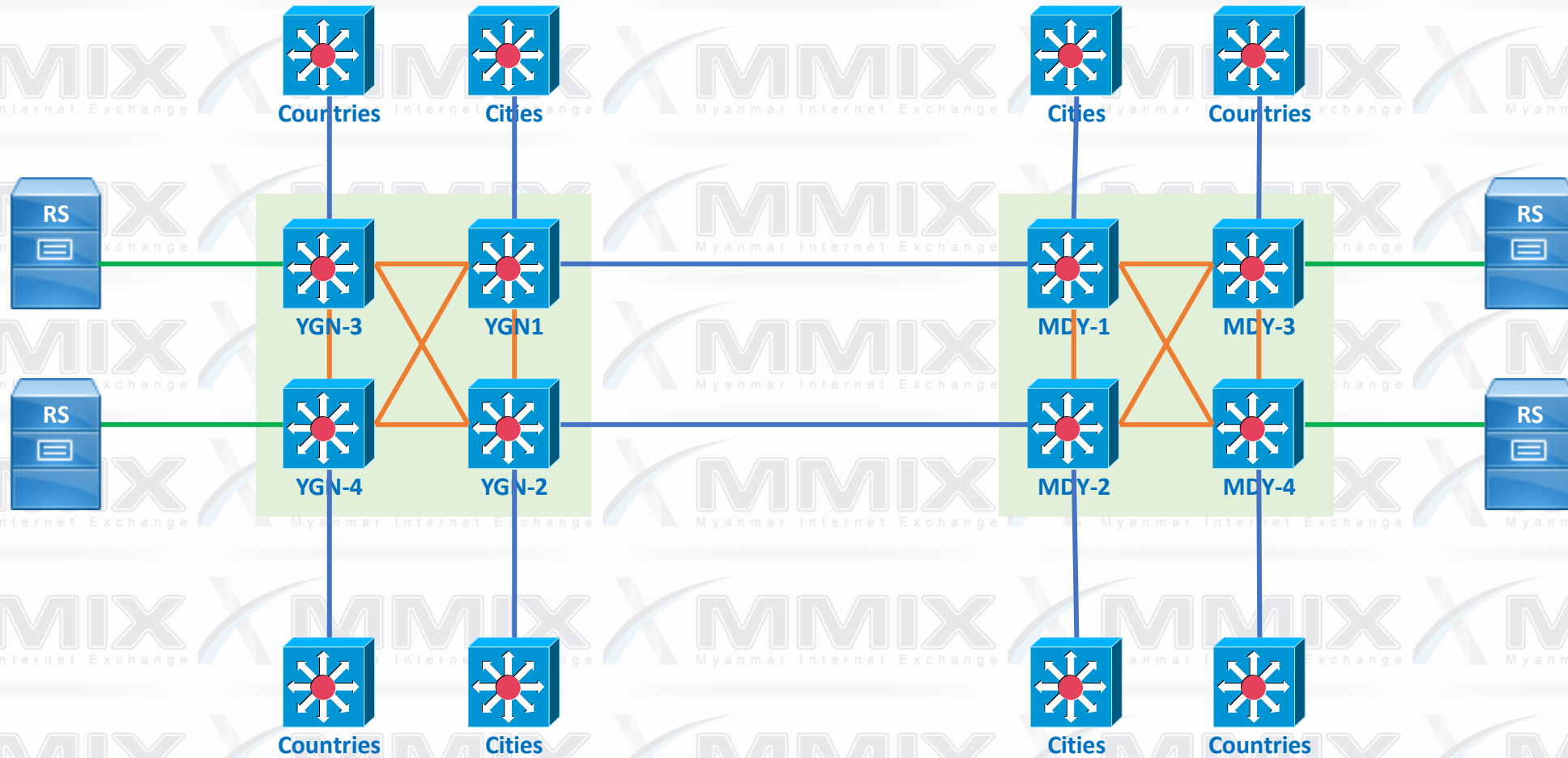
Aggregate Traffic(2017-24)

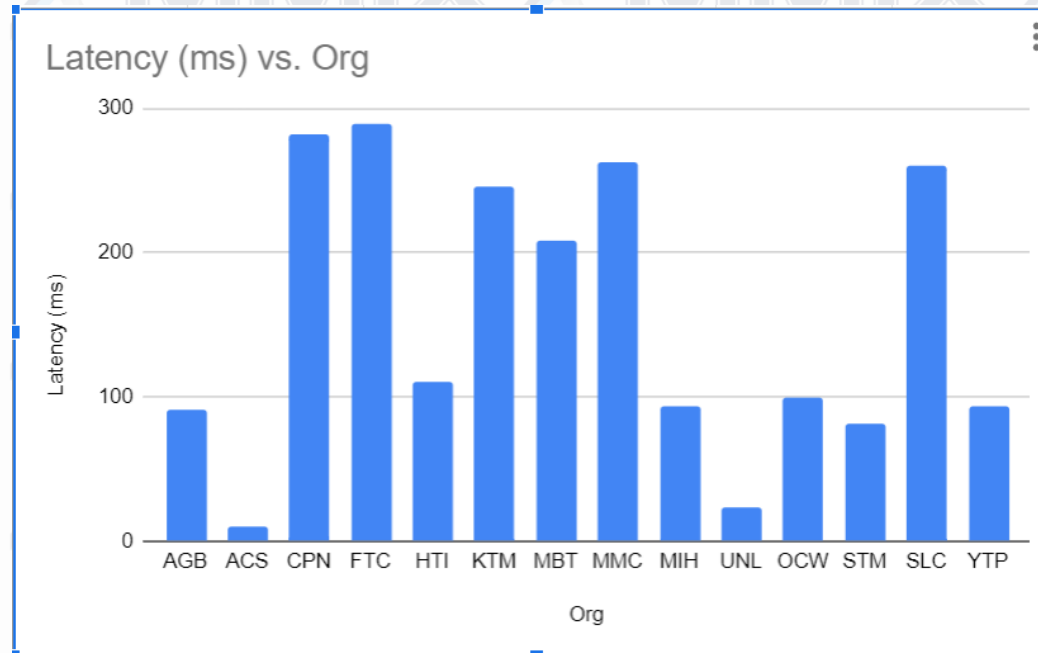
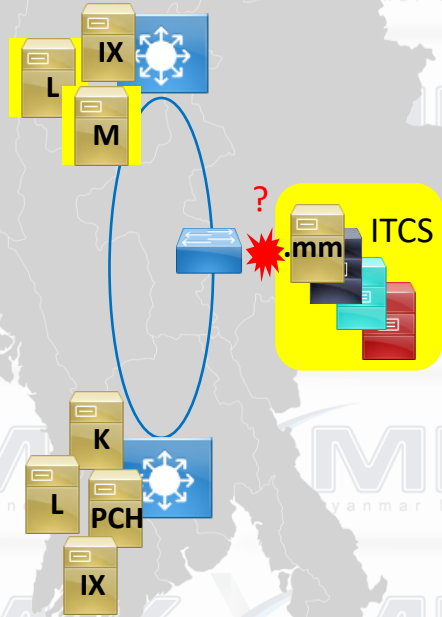

Latency result from the networks of the MMIX members to the Gateway IP 103.89.48.1 of ITCSD. <Mar-2023 data>

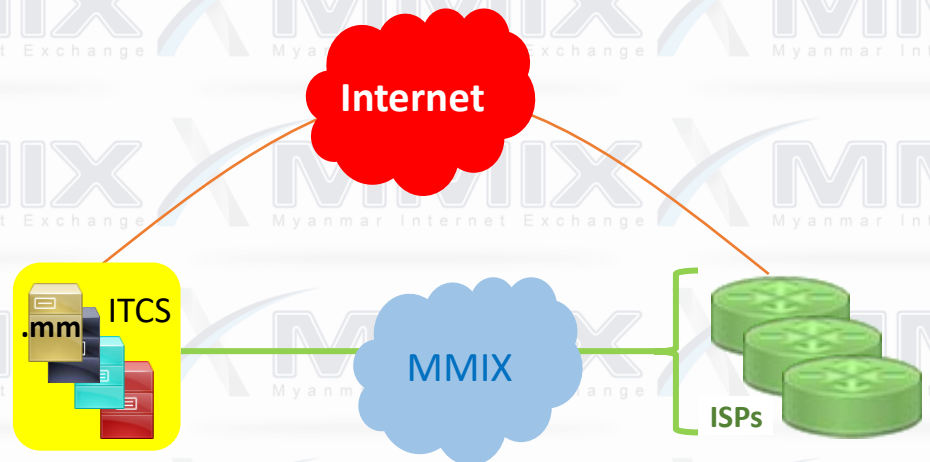


Latency >10ms, < 289ms. Average is 153.5 ms

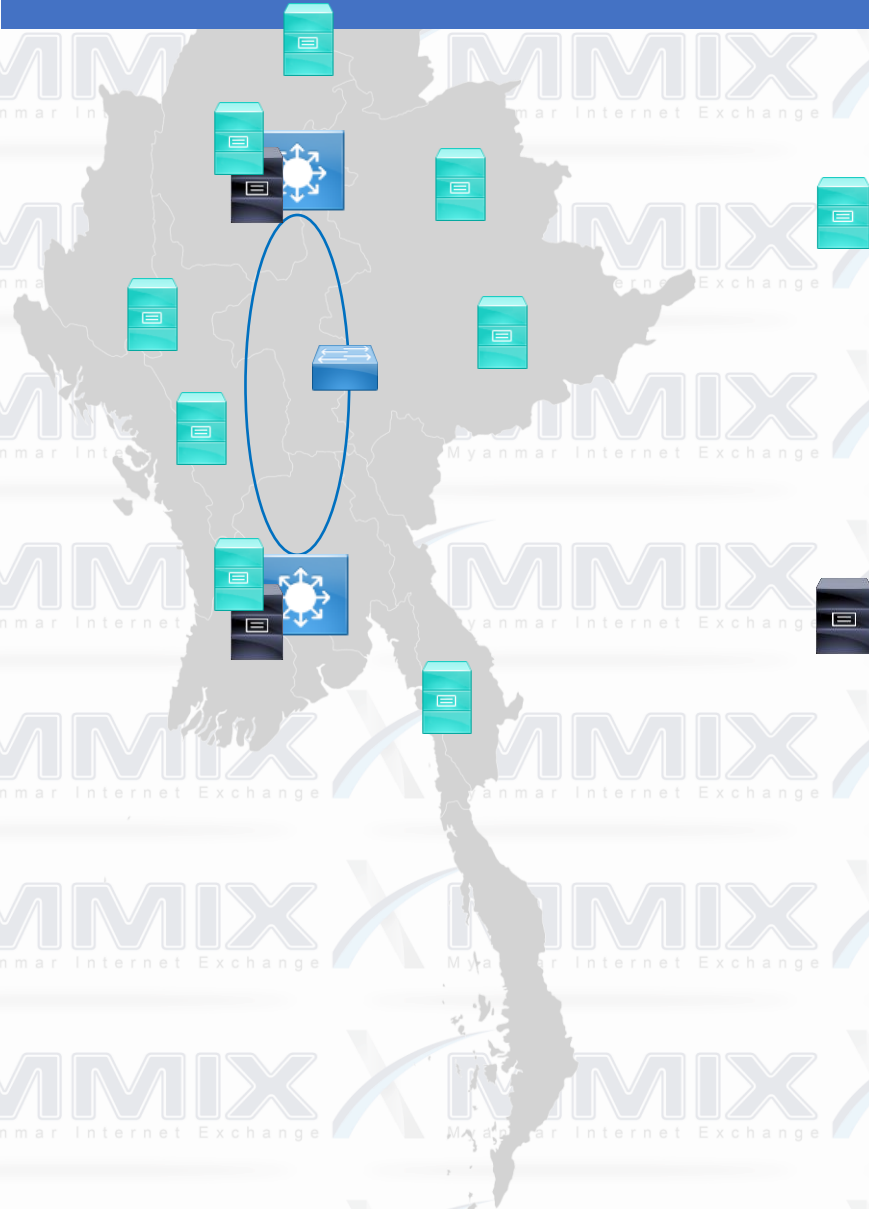
Apparently, latency high as no peering. Only peering can solve the problem.

Benefit after Gov. Networks connect to MMIX

Benefit	Conditions
Low Latency	Accessible smoothly from the networks of the members of MMIX
Internet Lost, still ok.	Still active locally when International links are cut off.
Internet Congest, still ok.	Accessible smoothly in local when International links are contested.
DDOS Attack, still ok	Accessible smoothly in local when there is DDOS attack from oversea.
Flexible security control	As direct connection with each ISPs, can control routing and security directly.



Local CDN and Local Cloud



Local CDN

- Setup distributed CDN for local content with affordable cost for content providers.
- Partnership with technical group or persons or organization for setup, manage and operate CDN Infrastructure.
- Invite content providers for hosting at MMIX CDN.

Local Cloud

- Setup non-commercial cloud for education society.
- Partnership with technical group or persons or organization for setup, manage and operate the cloud.
- Invite Universities and Institution for free access to MMIX Cloud.
